Dear Clerk,

Our Road Casualty Reduction Sergeant spent some time near the junction of Culm Valley Way today and issued a number of Offence Reports. The highest speed recorded inside the newly extended 30 MPH limit was 51 MPH.

We will try and deliver some visible enforcement at the location so-as to deter offenders but as we all know this will not bring a long-term or permanent solution to the problem.

That said, I am impressed to see the presence of the VAS at Silver Street on the B3181, especially because of it's potential to collect speed data and to provide a visible deterrent to the potential offender.

I don't want to interfere in Parish Council business, but I thought you wouldn't mind me suggesting some partnership work that might improve the situation for both parishes.

Essentially, would the Councils consider the following:

- Uffculme consider buying a VAS with advice from Willand
- Willand loaning the VAS to Uffculme for trial.
- Uffculme offering a contribution to any ongoing costs for a share of the VAS.
- Willand placing the VAS near Uffculme, on occasions but within their parish boundary.

Again, sorry if this is interference isn't helpful but it was just an idea.
